

Notification of Patent Infringement Demand to Cease & Desist

Our firm represents Zijiang Yang ("Yang") in his intellectual property and related matters. Yang is the owner of certain intellectual property rights regarding rifle and safety accessories, including U.S. Design Patent Number D893,180 ("the Yang Patent") (attached for your convenience) and related trade-dress rights. Our client has expended considerable time and sums of money to establish and maintain its valuable business and intellectual property rights.

It has recently come to Yang's attention that you are making, using, selling, and/or offering for sale, products ("the Accused Products") that Yang believes fall within the claim of the Yang Patent. At least one listing on your website offers one of the Accused Product for sale:

As you have now learned of Yang's claim, you have an ongoing legal duty to preserve all materials and evidence that may be relevant to those claims. These materials and evidence include, but are not limited to, letters, emails, text messages, advertising, websites and webpages, books and financial records, and other documents relating to, or showing, the Accused Products, their sale or offer for sale, and all other relevant materials, without time limits. You are required to take steps to prevent the spoliation of evidence. If you are taking down webpages or websites related in any way to the Accused Products, you are required to maintain copies of the webpages and websites as they existed prior to the changes. In litigation, if it becomes necessary for you to produce evidence in discovery and you fail to do so, it will be presumed that any destruction was intentional, in violation of your duty to preserve evidence.

In order to resolve the matter, on behalf of Yang, we demand that you immediately cease all sales, marketing, advertising, offers for sale, use and manufacture of the Accused Products, and any other product that also infringes the Yang Patent. We must also insist that you immediately recall all infringing products that you have sold or shipped to any of your distributors and/or retailers. In addition to the above, we must insist that you provide us with an accounting of the total volume of infringing products you have sold or otherwise distributed within the United States, to whom you have sold them, and your gross and net sales related to those products. Once you have satisfied these obligations, we will consider my client's settlement position with respect to your infringement of his patent.

We require a response and commitment within five (5) days from the date of this letter. Failing a satisfactory response and resolution, we will take all appropriate legal steps to protect Yang's rights.

FIG. 4 is a left-side elevational view of the rifle case of FIG.


FIG. 5 is a right-side elevational view of the rifle case of FIG. 1;
